The West Jackson CDC will sponsor the 26th Annual Lynch Street Cultural Arts Festival and Cabaret Style Banquet April 28-29, 2017.



Cabaret Style Banquet

Festival activities will begin with Friday night's opening event, a Cabaret Style Banquet. The purpose of this event is to bring back the spirit of past years when Lynch Street was one of the main thoroughfares of cultural activity in Jackson. Within the various nightclubs and theaters housed on Lynch Street, national and local singers, musicians, speakers, poets, and other entertainment would come and showcase their talents. Along with food and dancing, these activities created a festive, joyous atmosphere. West Jackson CDC's Cabaret Style Banquet attempts to recapture those days. The event will feature a regional/national artist(s), as well as a number of local artists.

Lynch Street Cultural Arts Festival

The Lynch Street Cultural Arts Festival presents a carnival-like setting that features a main stage on one end of Lynch Street and vendors selling food, books, t-shirts and other goods along the sidewalks of the streets. A National Recording Artist **TK Soul** will perform as the main attraction for both the Friday night opening event (Cabaret Style Banquet) and Saturday's featured vocalists. Some of our past year's featured artists include: Bobby Rush, PFunk Connection, Lenny Williams, Rick James's Stone City Band, Motown Contours, Lattimore, Manhattans, Bar-Kays and the Soul Children, Midnight Star, J. Blackfoot, Lakeside, Bobby Womack, Willie Clayton, Harold Melvin's Blue Notes, The Chi-Lites, The Dramatics, The Delphonics, Bobby "Blue" Bland, Bobby Rush, G.C. Cameron, Mel Waiters, Betty Wright, Jesse Robinson, Denise LaSalle, and O'neal Hudson and the Mighty Up-Setters. In addition to the featured artist, other local artists are featured during Friday and Saturdays event.

The Children's Village

The Children's Village includes a variety of cultural, artistic, and educational activities for youth. A children's train ride will be provided that travels all over the festival site with 5-10 young passengers. A space jump, arts and crafts, balloons and a variety of other games will be available in the Children's Village. This section will also be the site of the African-American Storytelling sessions. Children within West Jackson CDC's target area do not receive many opportunities to see and participate in many cultural and/or artistic events. Therefore, by insuring that area children are exposed to and have the opportunity to participate in various arts activities, the Lynch Street Cultural Arts Festival dramatically increases arts awareness and education among these children, and is provided *free* to the public.
